

Three steps to get started:

Onboarding

• CTE Regional Coordinator onboarding meeting

 Provide list of district/school contacts for data import and training

Data

- Student Data Privacy Consortium agreement
- Student Information System sync or spreadsheet import

Training

- April: Regional training sessions to record student participation and partners
- May: Automated ODE report and SIS export

And then add on these optional modules:

Industry-recognized credentials

- Record by viewing your CTE course/section rosters and using our bulk participation form
- Generate an IRC report using our template for ODE and an export to Synergy

Track any Career Connected Learning

- Guest speaker, career day, job shadow, site visits, and other student registrations
